

Pinkus: Organic Beer from Germany on Draft!

Ready to serve and enjoy a beer on draft like no other?

A delicious, historical beer style originated in the Germany city of Münster centuries ago: a pale, crisp ale with enticing acidity and light body: **Münster alt**. Unlike brown altbiers from Dusseldorf, 60 miles away, the variety brewed in Münster was pale, hazy gold.

Today, **Pinkus Münster Alt** is the remaining example of this wonderful beer style. Made from Certified Organic German hops, barley and wheat malt, Pinkus uses complex fermentation: a portion of the beer is subjected to lactic fermentation, added back to the kettle, then re-boiled (kettle-souring). Final fermentation is via a fruity ale yeast. There's no other beer like it!

Pinkus Brewery, in Münster, Germany, opened in 1816 and is still owned and operated by the founding family. They are the first brewery of the modern era to move to all-organic production, in the 1980s.



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
